

Dear Father Josukutty,

I am **Mr. Roshanraj Baliarsing**, son of Mr. Rajkumar Baliarsingh and Mrs. Padmini Baliarsingh (At/PO-Mohagudi, Tajungi Panchayat, Daringbadi block, Dist-Phulbani, Pin-762021). I was born on the 19/05/2004 in Mohagudi and I am the 3rd child of my family. I have two elder sisters and one younger brother. The eldest sister is doing her graduation in the science stream in Karuna Shanti Residential College and she is in her 2nd year of graduation. The second elder sister is in the convent in Kerala with the St. Benedictine sisters preparing herself for nunhood. I am the 3rd elder son in the family and I am studying in the 2nd year of my intermediate in **Karuna Shanti +2 Science Residential College** in the science stream. The youngest boy in the family is in his 10th standard in one of the jesuites' schools in our district (Loyola School, Pajikiri) where I too finished my 10th. Both my parents are alive. My father is a daily wage earner and does not have a constant and regular source of income. Last year he was in Kerala for work (as a migrant labourer) and then moved to Bengaluru but due to some family problems he came back home. My mother is a housewife and does not have any source of income in the village. She is busy taking care of the household in the family and is not able to take up any hard work due to her poor health conditions and ailments.



Studywise all the boys and girls in the family, we are good in it and have secured first grades in our 10th board exams in the state of Odisha. My elder sister is pursuing her graduation in the science stream and I too am doing my intermediary studies in science. In the 10th state board exam I secured 68%. Currently I am studying in Karuna Shanti +2 Science Residential College, Berahampur founded by one of the renowned social workers in the area. In my first year I secured 72% and currently preparing for NEET as well. I do take up other competitive exams for various scholarships and it helps me in my studies. At the moment I am a bright student in the class and being appreciated by the teachers and administration.

The fees for the entire course is Rs. 120,000/- and per year it's Rs. 60,000/- including tuition, loading and boarding at the institute itself. The amount has to be paid in full before the end of the academic year of each session. Due to the shortage of fund at home and my parents being not able to pay I am lagging behind in the payment of the fees for the first year itself. I do have

other personal expenses for my monthly needs and necessities. On one hand it's me that I have to spend so much money on the education on the other hand my sister as well as brother too need support for their education which my dad is not able to provide for. In a month my average personal expenses come to around Rs. 1500/- (Notes, soap, oil, pens, pencils, papers etc.).

Dear father, since the July 2021 you have been sending me financial help of Rs. 6000/- per month till date. I have used that money for paying off my fees, meeting my personal expenses etc. till date you have sent me **Rs.36,000/-** and I have paid off Rs. 30,000/- towards my college fees. I still have to pay rest of the money before I finish my course.

Therefore, I would need and request support from you till I finish my studies. I am sure I will be greatly helped and supported with your financial support towards my studies.
